2-DAY BASIC FIRE FIGHTING

Location

The course is held at the Fremont Maritime Training Center, located at 1900 West Nickerson Street, Suite 200, Seattle, WA 98119. The training day begins at 0800 and concludes at approximately 1700. A break for lunch is provided between 12:00pm and 1:00pm each day.

Content

This course has been approved by the U.S. Coast Guard as meeting the fire training requirements of 46 CFR 13.207, 13.307(a), 13.407, and 13.507, and Table A-VI/1-2 of the STCW 95 Code. Participants successfully completing the program will receive a certificate of completion.

Format

Mornings are spent in class, afternoons are devoted to outside training exercises in and around our vessel mock-up.

Clothing

You will need natural fiber shirts and long pants (or coveralls) each day. No polyester! Half of each day is spent outside, even if it is raining, so be prepared! Students without appropriate attire will not be allowed to participate in the class.

Physical Exam

In order to participate in practical fire fighting sessions, students must be in good physical condition with no medical conditions which could limit or be aggravated by heavy physical exertion. You will be asked to complete a medical questionnaire and disclaimer on the first day of class to determine suitability to participate in training. Fremont Maritime Services reserves the right to require a physician's examination where suitability is uncertain.

Facial Hair

Students should be clean shaven in order to obtain an airtight mask seal.

Payment

Cost of this program is \$495.00 per participant. We accept MasterCard, VISA, Checks, Cash, and purchase orders from approved clients. Cancellation

If you need to cancel or reschedule, please notify us as soon as possible. If you cancel more than seven days before the first day of class, you are entitled to a full refund, less a \$75.00 processing fee. No-shows who have not provided seven days written or verbal notification of cancellation will forfeit payment. If your employer signs you up and you fail to show, your employer will be invoiced.
