India Tango Marine Fire Training Program



ADVANCED FIREFIGHTING

Location

The course is held at the Fremont Maritime Training Center, located at 1019 West Ewing Street, Seattle, WA 98119. The training day begins at 0800 and concludes at approximately 1700. A break for lunch is provided between 1200 and 1300 each day.

Prerequisite

Prior to being accepted into this class, prospective students must have completed the India Tango Basic Firefighting class within the past six months.

Content

When combined with the India Tango Basic Fire Fighting class, the Advanced Fire Fighting program is Coast Guard-approved as meeting the fire training requirements of 46CFR §13.207, §13.307(a), §13.407, §13.507, §10.205(g), and Tables A-VI/1-2 and A-VI/3 of the STCW 95 Code. Participants successfully completing the program will receive a certificate of completion.

Format

Mornings are spent in class; afternoons are devoted to outside training exercises in and around our vessel mock-up.

Clothing

You will need long-sleeved shirts and long pants (or coveralls) each day. Clothing should be of natural fiber. No polyester! Half of each day is spent outside, even if it is raining, so be prepared! Students without appropriate attire will not be allowed to participate in the class.

Physical Fitness

In order to participate in practical firefighting sessions, students must be in good physical condition with no medical conditions which could limit or be aggravated by heavy physical exertion. You will be asked to complete a medical questionnaire and disclaimer on the first day of class to determine suitability to participate in training. Fremont Maritime Services reserves the right to require a physician's examination where suitability is uncertain. If you have any doubt as to whether it is safe for you to participate, Fremont Maritime strongly recommends you consult your physician prior to registration.

Facial Hair

Students should be clean shaven in order to obtain an airtight mask seal.

Payment

Cost of this program is \$625.00 per participant. We accept all major credit cards, as well as cash and personal checks. Payment should be made at the time of registration, or we cannot guarantee your place in the class. No shows who have not provided 7 days written or verbal notification of cancellation will forfeit payment.

Lodging
